It was announced on the news that new information was reported that at least two New York Fire Fighters made it to the 78th floor of the World Trade Center. These smoke eaters "dug in" and went 25 floors further than anyone expected them to before the building came crashing down around them. Another maximum effort.

When Chief Connealy resigned from this union, I was disappointed and saddened. I know we are miles apart on everything but don't bail – "dig in".

Local 341 is in business for all Fire Fighters. If you don't like the way George LaRue is doing things, vote me out. We had around 900 votes cast in this last election. We have over 3000 Union members and the complaints are up and the participation is down. I don't care how bad it gets, I'm not leaving. Thank you Fire Fighters for re-electing me to my 2nd term.
