First paid Houston firefighter to die in the line of duty. Killed falling off horse-drawn Hose Wagon #5 into the path of a freight train.

Killed when horse-drawn Hose Wagon #8 overturned at the corner of McKinney and Jackson.

Died while driving Assistant Chief Arto's buggy en route to pick up the Chief and respond to a fire at 1611 Franklin.

Died while fighting the Stower's Building fire when a heavy building timber fell on him.





Died when Engine #9 was struck by a streetcar while en route to a fire at the Bluefront Boarding House.





Was killed while responding to a fire at 2707 Grant Street when he was struck by a chimney that collapsed while he and his crew were attacking the fire from the back porch.





Died when he was struck in the head by a hose coupling as he attempted to connect Engine #10 to a hydrant.

Died when he was electrocuted by an electrical line that had burned loose during a house fire at 3552 Reeves Street.

July of 1929, the Houston Fire Department experienced the first multiple line-of-duty deaths when Engine #18 was struck broadside by a train. Grant died at the scene.

Was killed when his muledrawn supply wagon was hit by a train crossing the tracks at Johnson Street.

Was killed attempting to put on his fire coat when the engine he was riding hit a twelve-inch hole in the street throwing him from the vehicle.

Assignment: Firefighter at the Central Station

Died after Auto Service Truck #1 slammed into Car #119 of the Galveston-Houston Electric Railway Company as he and two other firefighters were riding on the side of the truck.

Was killed at a fire at Texas Lamp and Oil Company when a backdraft caused three barrels of denatured alcohol to explode, blowing out a wall trapping Harris and seven other firefighters.

Died when Ladder Truck #1 struck a passenger car and a streetcar at the intersection of Dallas and Milam.



Born: November 3, 1870 Galveston, Texas Died: August 4, 1923 Age at Death: 53 Entered the Fire Department: 1895 Assignment: First Assistant Chief at the Central Station

Was killed while riding Chemical #1 when it hit a telephone pole trying to avoid a collision with a car at the intersection of Congress and Hamilton.





Born: July 3, 1895 Dallas, Texas Died: July 3, 1929 Age at Death: 34 Entered the Fire Department: November 16, 1928 Assignment: Firefighter at Fire Station #18

Died the day after sustaining injuries when Engine #18 was hit broadside by a train.



Born: November 19, 1883 Knoxville, Tennessee Died: July 11, 1929 Age at Death: 46 Entered the Fire Department: June 4, 1913 Assignment: Captain at Fire Station #18

Died nine days after sustaining injuries in the accident that killed Firefighters Grant and Oxford.



Born: September 15, 1906 Died: December 20, 1929 Age at Death: 23 Entered the Fire Department: July 12, 1929 Assignment: Firefighter at Fire

Station #19

Killed with Firefighter Ward when Engine #19 was struck by a train only five months after a similar accident took the lives of Firefighters Grant, Oxford and Little.

Was fatally injured when Ladder #14, en route to a house fire, was struck by an eastbound streetcar at 17th and Yale.



Born: May 18, 1906 Buckholtz, Texas Died: August 22, 1934 Age at Death: 28 Entered the Fire Department: September 1929 Assignment: Firefighter at Fire Station #17

Was killed when Engine #24, en route to a location, collided with a streetcar crushing him between the two vehicles. Due to a firefighter shortage, Rogers was substituting for another firefighter at Station #24.



Born: September 22, 1887 Location unknown Died: August 21, 1938 Age at Death: 51 Entered the Fire Department: November 5, 1917 Assignment: District Chief at Fire Station #7

Died when the Chief's Chemical #1 Truck, housed at Station #7, overturned as it hit an esplanade while responding to a house fire at 2012 Bolsover.



Born: October 23, 1881 Millican, Texas Died: July 1, 1940 Age at Death: 59 Entered the Fire Department: March 1, 1914 Assignment: Driver at Fire Station #2

Died 18 months after sustaining injuries when the reserve pumper he was driving collided with a city bus. Nicknamed after Molly Cottontail, from the Peter Rabbit books, when he began raising rabbits in cages behind the station.



Born: July 18, 1904 Winsboro, Texas Died: August 6, 1941 Age at Death: 37 Entered the Fire Department: September 1928 Assignment: Pipe and Ladderman at Fire Station #10

Killed while riding Service Truck #1, en route to a large supermarket fire when Engine #2 collided into the rear of the vehicle. Gassoway was temporarily assigned to Station #1 due to a manpower shortage.



Born: June 26, 1923 Houston, Texas Died: March 31, 1947 Age at Death: 24 Entered the Fire Department: January 1946 Assignment: Firefighter at Fire Station #26

Was killed instantly when Engine #26 was hit by a train on the way to a fire at the Eastern States Refinery. He had been married just two weeks, returning from his honeymoon just six days before his death.



Born: February 25, 1899 Wheelock, Texas Died: March 7, 1948 Age at Death: 49 Entered the Fire Department: January 22, 1941 Assignment: Firefighter at Fire Station #18

Died of a massive heart attack on location of a small house fire at 2840 Lidstone.



Born: November 15, 1902 Nacogdoches, Texas Died: January 21, 1949 Age at Death: 47 Entered the Fire Department: December 5, 1919 Assignment: Assistant Fire Chief at the Central Station

Killed while responding to a fire at the Hub Lumber Company, 5519 Lawndale, when his Chief's car collided with a passenger vehicle.



Born: March 31, 1911 Palestine, Texas Died: April 14, 1949 Age at Death: 38 Entered the Fire Department: September 4, 1933 Assignment: Driver at Fire Station #7

Died while responding to a false alarm at the corner of McGowen and Sauer. The Chief's car he was driving collided with a pick-up truck at Fannin and McGowen.



Born: April 1900 Houston, Texas Died: January 31, 1951 Age at Death: 50 Entered the Fire Department: January 1, 1922 Assignment: Chauffeur at the Central Station

Died of a heart attack on location at a fire at the Alaskan Fur Factory on Main Street.



Born: October 5, 1894 New Iberia, Louisiana Died: March 12, 1951 Age at Death: 57 Entered the Fire Department: January 1, 1922 Assignment: Captain at Fire Station #5

Died from a massive heart attack while fighting a fire at the Alaskan Fur Company at Main and Texas, during freezing weather and icy conditions.

Died of a heart attack while on location of a fire at the Frederick Poultry and Egg Company at 1817 Center.



Born: April 24, 1918 Moore, Texas Died: July 29, 1953 Age at Death: 35 Entered the Fire Department: October 4, 1951 Assignment: Firefighter at Fire Station #1

Was killed with Firefighter Solito when Engine #8 and Ladder #1 collided at the intersection of Preston and Crawford.

Many factors contributed to the accident that killed Firefighters Chabolla and Solito. Engine #1 had trouble starting which delayed it's response and Engine #8 was replacing Engine #10 that was on another call. Both apparatus reached the intersection at the same time.

Born: November 6, 1914 Houston, Texas Died: December 18, 1954 Age at Death: 40 Entered the Fire Department: December 11, 1941 Assignment: Chauffeur at Fire Station #19

Was fatally injured when the District Chief's car he was driving collided with a Houston Transit Company Bus at Lockwood and Lyons. He was scheduled to be off-duty when the alarm was dispatched.



Born: April 17, 1927 Madisonville, Texas Died: November 6, 1959 Age at Death: 32 Entered the Fire Department: June 1, 1953 Assignment: Firefighter at Fire Station #30

Was killed along with Firefighter Jedlicka when Engine #30 was struck by a transport truck carrying steel at the intersection of Berry and Fulton.



Born: December 13, 1932 Rusk, Texas Died: November 9, 1959 Age at Death: 27 Entered the Fire Department: July 1, 1958 Assignment: Firefighter at Fire Station #19

Died while fighting a fire aboard the Amoco Virginia a 150,000 gallon tanker ship. During fire cleanup, he fell through a hole in the deck and drown in the ship's hold that was full of gasoline.





Born: September 27, 1922 Cameron, Texas Died: November 17, 1959 Age at Death: 37 Entered the Fire Department: June 1, 1953 Assignment: Firefighter at Fire Station #30

Died eleven days after sustaining severe injuries in the accident that also claimed the life of Firefighter McWhorter and injured two other firefighters.



Born: March 12, 1911 Houston, Texas Died: May 21, 1962 Age at Death: 51 Entered the Fire Department: December 16, 1941 Assignment: Firefighter at Fire Station #37

Died 19 days after suffering a severe heart attack while fighting a 2-alarm fire at the Wanda Petroleum Company on Almeda-Genoa Road.



Born: January 20, 1932 Bryan, Texas Died: June 30, 1962 Age at Death: 30 Entered the Fire Department: November 1, 1956 Assignment: Chauffeur at Fire Station #2

Was fatally injured as he was driving Ladder #2 en route to a sprinkler alarm at the Bayou Products Company when it collided with a transport truck carrying grain.



Born: July 9, 1907 Chappell Hill, Texas Died: February 3, 1969 Age at Death: 62 Entered the Fire Department: December 11, 1941 Assignment: Captain at Fire Station #37

Died of a heart attack on location of a house fire at 3931 Underwood during the after fire clean up.



Killed at the infamous Mykawa Road catastrophe where two railroad tank cars, one carrying vinyl chloride and the other butadiene, exploded. The blasts came 40 minutes apart with the second doing the most damage and killing firefighter Hathaway.



Born: January 18, 1916 Groveton, Texas Died: February 3, 1973 Age at Death: 57 Entered the Fire Department: August 1, 1941 Assignment: Captain at Fire Station #7

Died as a result of a heart attack while fighting an intense apartment fire at 1400 Richmond. The large amount of heat and smoke contributed to the attack.



Born: August 17, 1933 Austin, Texas Died: February 4, 1977 Age at Death: 44 Entered the Fire Department: July 16, 1956 Assignment: Senior Captain at Fire Station #7

Suffered a fatal heart attack while fighting a fire at 3700 Wheeler months after his knowledge as a firefighter was tested. His instinct at that fire helped save the lives of several firefighters from a serious flashover incident.

Born: February 17, 1959 Pine Bluff, Arkansas Died: September 23, 1982 Age at Death: 23 Entered the Fire Department: February 8, 1982 Assignment: Probationary Firefighter at Fire Station #1

Died as a result of injuries sustained as Engine #1 was responding to a trash fire. Firefighter Cooper attempted to stop a rolled hose from falling off the apparatus while on route and he lost his balance and fell.



Born: November 23, 1929 Houston, Texas Died: January 4, 1983 Age at Death: 54 Entered the Fire Department: August 5, 1950 Assignment: District Chief at Fire Station #7

Was killed when his District Chief's car was struck broadside by passenger vehicle at the intersection of Elgin and Hutchins.

1990-2000



Born: August 30, 1952 Houston, Texas Died: December 1, 1984 Age at Death: 32 Entered the Fire Department: January 26, 1981 Assignment: Firefighter at Fire Station #62

Fell to his death off Engine #15 while traveling on the North Freeway to a car fire.



Born: October 12, 1957 Victoria, Texas Died: December 4, 1996 Age at Death: 39 Entered the Fire Department: 1987 Assignment: District Chief at Fire Station #25

Died during a flashover incident at a house fire at 4006 Roseneath while attempting to rescue trapped victims. Firefighter Lopez is the only Houston Volunteer death in the history of HFD.



Born: October 5, 1951 Pasadena, Texas Died: December 2, 1998 Age at Death: 47 Entered the Fire Department: March 31, 1975 Assignment: Firefighter at Fire Station #92

Died from a heart attack while participating, with other airport firefighters, in a live burn at the DFW Airport in Dallas, Texas.



Born: December 13, 1955 Florida Died: February 14, 2000 Age at Death: 45 Entered the Fire Department: June 29, 1981 Assignment: Firefighter at Fire Station #76

Killed along with Firefighter Smith when they responded to a fire at a McDonald's restaurant at 12602 Bissonnet. Both firefighters died when the ceiling collapsed on top of them as they entered the location.



Born: November 20, 1969 El Paso, Texas Died: February 14, 2000 Age at Death: 30 Entered the Fire Department: April 11, 1994 Assignment: Firefighter at Fire Station #76

It was determined that the fire that killed Firefighters Mayo and Smith was started by teenagers who set the structure on fire after several failed attempts to break in. Smith is the first female firefighter killed in the line of duty.



Born: September 16, 1961 Houston, Texas Died: October 13, 2001 Age at Death: 40 Entered the Fire Department: December 2, 1981 Assignment: Captain at Fire Station #2

Died while fighting a 6-alarm high-rise fire in the Galleria area. He is buried next to his beloved father, Claude.



Born: November 2, 1971 Died: April 4, 2004 Age at Death: 32 Entered the Fire Department: September 15, 2003 Assignment: Probationary Firefighter at Fire Station #50

Died at the scene of a fire involving hazardous materials on Kempwood Street. After entering the facility, the fire intensified and Firefighter Kulow was unable to reach safety.



Born: January 31, 1966 Died: February 19, 2005 Age at Death: 39 Entered the Fire Department: March 3, 1993 Assignment: Captain at Fire Station #46

Killed fighting a fire at an abandoned building in the 8500 block of Bradon, when the roof collapsed almost immediately as Captain Burke and his crew entered the structure.



Born: May 18, 1958 Beeville, Texas Died: April 12, 2009 Age at Death: 50 Entered the Fire Department: August 1979 Assignment: Captain at Fire Station #26

Was killed with Firefighter Hobbs on Easter morning as the crew of Station 26 were responding to a house fire at 7811 Oak Vista. Harlow and Hobbs entered the house to rescue the elderly residents unaware they had already escaped the fire and were safe.


Was killed along with Captain Harlow only one month after graduating for the HFD Training Academy. Firefighter Hobbs enrolled in the academy after serving 2 tours of duty in Iraq with the U. S. Army. This was his first fire.






